



# LICENSE APPORTIONMENT FEES EXAMPLE >>

As an example of how license apportionment fees are calculated, the sample below demonstrates how fees would be determined for an 80,000 pound tractor based in Pennsylvania that travels in Pennsylvania, Maryland, Tennessee and Virginia. The total mileage for the tractor/trailer was 100,000 with exactly 25,000 miles accrued in each jurisdiction.

Jurisdiction	Distance (mi)	Percentage	Base Jurisdiction Fees*	Total Calculation	Total Fees
Maryland	25,000	25%	\$1,280.00	$1,280 \times 0.25 =$ \$320.00	\$320.00
Pennsylvania	25,000	25%	\$1,687.50	$1,687.50 \times 0.25 =$ \$421.88	\$421.88
Tennessee	25,000	25%	\$1,366.00	$1,366.00 \times 0.25 =$ \$341.50	\$341.50
Virginia	25,000	25%	\$1,319.50	$1,319.50 \times 0.25 =$ \$329.88	\$329.88
<b>Total</b>	<b>100,000</b>	<b>100%</b>		<b>Total Amount in this example, to be paid to each Jurisdiction</b>	<b>\$1,413.26</b>
